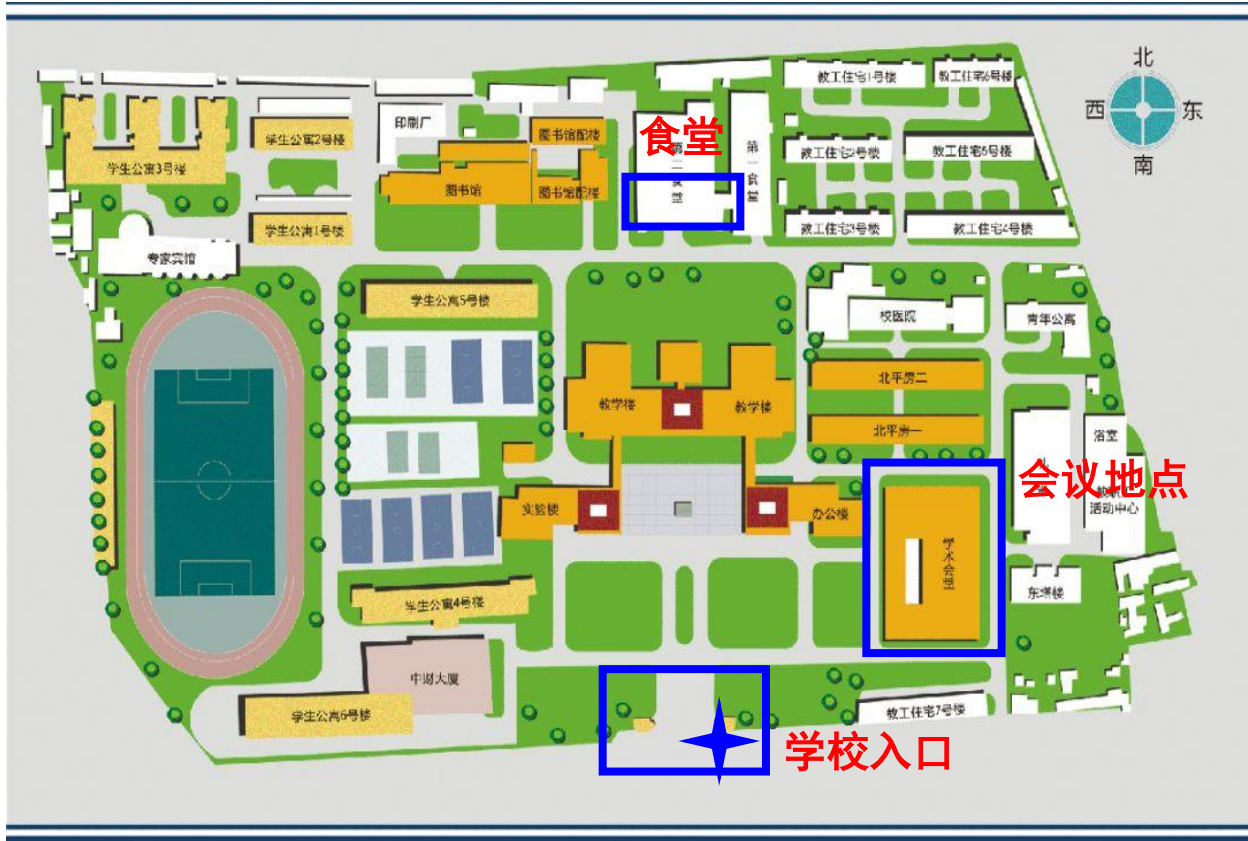

中央财经大学经济学院简介

中央财经大学是教育部直属，教育部、财政部和北京市共建的大学，是国家“双一流”建设、“211 工程”建设和首批“优势学科创新平台”项目建设高校。学校形成了以经济学、管理学和法学学科为主体，文学、理学、工学、教育学、艺术学等多学科协调发展的学科体系。

经济学院是中央财经大学实行学院制以来建立的第一批学院，是学校拥有国家级重点学科最多的学院，学院拥有 4 个国家级重点学科、2 个北京市重点学科，拥有理论经济学与应用经济学两个一级学科，拥有学士学位、硕士学位、博士学位授予点以及博士后流动站，培养体系完备。在教育部公布的第四轮学科评估中，我校应用经济学排名与北京大学、中国人民大学并列第一，理论经济学排名在财经类院校中并列第一，学科建设成效显著。学院师资力量雄厚，拥有国家级高层次人才 51 人次，科研成果突出，主持国家社科基金重大项目等课题 100 余项。

学院人才培养成效显著，经济学和国民经济管理两个本科专业全部入选国家级一流本科专业，数字经济时代经济学拔尖学生培养基地为教育部首批基础学科拔尖学生培养计划 2.0 基地，2025 年学院新增数字经济（成思危拔尖班）本科专业、数字经济专业硕士、经济学数据科学国际硕士项目。学院党建特色突出，获评全国党建工作标杆院系、北京高校先进基层党组织、首批全国高校“双带头人”教师党支部书记工作室、北京高校德育工作先进集体等荣誉。

Department of Economics was founded on July 5, 1984, and became school of economics on May 29th, 2000, which was one of the first schools at CUFÉ. Prior to this, Chen Daisun, Liu Guangdi, Sun Kaiyong and other famous economists made great contributions to CUFÉ and laid a solid foundation for the School of Economics. Under the leadership of Hou Ronghua, Jin Zhesong and Zhao Lifen, Huang Shaoan, Yang Yunjie, Li Tao, Chen Binkai and Guo Dongmei, it has been developing rapidly during the past years. The School of Economics offers both a concentration in economics for undergraduate students and the doctoral program for graduate students. We now have 71 faculty members and 12 staff, including 27 professors, 27 associate professors and 18 assistant professors. They teach and do research in the areas of Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Econometrics, International Economics, Industrial Economics, Political Economy, Economic History, Urban Economics, and Labor economics.

The School of Economics aims to the excellence in both research and teaching for the purpose of advancing knowledge and practical policy advising. On the heels of China's strong economic performance over the last decades, the Chinese economy has been drawing the global attention from the perspective of economic research. We are committed to combining China roots with the modern economic tools to enhance our understanding in the Chinese economy, and further hope to contribute to its development as well as to make a global impact. All the faculty members hold the Ph.D. degree from prestigious universities in the world, like Peking University, Tsinghua University, Renmin University of China, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, University of Minnesota, UCLA, Boston College, Boston University, University of Southern California, Texas A&M University, University of Maryland, among others. The international education backgrounds of faculty members make our School a diversified, open-minded department. Our faculty members have been extensively involved in international academic activities. Their research works were presented at important domestic and international conferences, like American Economic Association Annual Meeting, Econometric Society Meetings, NBER, etc.

In addition to academic activities, the School of Economics has also actively pursued applied research in areas relevant to the government sector and policy advising. For example, faculty members collaborate with China Development Bank, the Ministry of Finance of the Government of the People's Republic of China, the Ministry of Agriculture of the Government of the People's Republic of China, World Bank, the Hoover Institution and other institutes.

The School of Economics today is ranked among the top institutions in China for teaching and research in the study of economics. Our faculty members have published papers in top Chinese academic journals, like *Social Sciences in China*, *Economic Research Journal* among others, and also decent English academic journals, and also decent English academic journals, like *Review of Economic Statistics*, *Economic Journal*, *Journal of Monetary Economics*, *Journal of Development Economics*, *Journal of Econometrics*, *Management Science* among many others. The School of Economics has been placing great importance on collaborating with universities and institutions around the world. We have established many joint training programs with prestigious universities, like Cornell University, University of Wisconsin-Madison, Okayama University, Kang won National University. We are also engaged in many "student exchange programs" with the University of British Columbia, University of Cambridge, University of Michigan and other universities.
